

Community of Interest (CoI) Workshop on Gender Integration March 29-30 2017, at SWEDINT | NCGM, Royal Lifeguards, Sweden

The Nordic Centre for Gender in Military Operations (NCGM) will host the the Community of Interest Workshop on Gender in Military Operations at the at NCGM the Lifeguards Regiment in Kungsängen, Sweden, between **29-30 Mar 2017**.

The Community of Interest (CoI) workshop aims to support the training community in identifying tools and developing solutions for meeting the gender related requirements in other relevant disciplines.

The CoI workshop offers an opportunity to gather the training community to discuss training requirements with NATO allies and partners prior to the Annual Discipline Conference (ADC). The ADC 2017 will be held on May 29th 2017 at NATO HQ in Brussels, Belgium (separate invitation to follow).

Aim - Community of Interest (CoI)

NCS and NFS representatives, DHs, education and training facilities (ETFs), subject matter experts (SMEs) and other actors will discuss the following subjects during the workshop:

- (1) How to integrate cross-cutting themes in individual training and exercises;
- (2) Best practices of Gender integration in training;
- (3) Updates on new requirements identified with relations to gender, to address NATO current and future operations;
- (4) Identified E&T gaps open to ETF's to fill upon interest and request;
- (5) Available solutions and tools

Methodology

The CoI Workshop on gender 2017 will be conducted through round table and open discussions, complemented by seminar sessions led by selected SMEs. Participants from NCS/NFS, HQ SACT, DHs and ETFs are expected to openly share their views on the proposed topics, stimulating a positive exchange of knowledge, skills and competencies concerning gender.

Expected Results

The workshop aims to identify tools and solutions for meeting the discipline related requirements relevant to other NATO disciplines training solutions. It is a possibility to share best practices and lessons learned and an opportunity to bring different partners and actors closer to each other in order to enhance our common efforts in the work with integration of UNSCR 1325 and related resolutions and gender perspective into training, military operations and activities.
