HALMSTAD GARRISON & THE AIR DEFENCE REGIMENT

Halmstad Garrison was founded in 1906 (present Air Defence Regiment) and expanded with an air base in 1944. Halmstad Garrison is one of the largest garrisons in Sweden. In total the Swedish Armed Forces employs approximately 1 500 people in Halmstad. The garrison has a very good cooperation with other authorities and the civil society in Halmstad. The Garrison is expanding and the military presence is getting more and more noticeable in and around Halmstad.

The Swedish Air Defence Regiment maintain high readiness against airborne threats together with the Air Force. The Air Defence regiment trains conscripts drafted for military service, educates Officers and NCO:s at the Military Academy which is located in Halmstad and part of the Garrison and also has the responsibility to maintain and develop tactical warfare and technical advancements concerning the air defence in the Swedish Armed Forces.



ARRIVAL

At arrival, all members of the mission must report immediately at the Information Center. The members of the mission will receive information about storage of weapons, ammo, keys, control of military status, accreditation cards etc.

You are also requested to update the Information Center about your departure; needs for transport and time of departure.

ACCREDITATION

Accreditation card

Each person involved in the championship will be given an accreditation card entitling him/her to access relevant facilities around the Regimental area and the competition sites. You need to show your passport in order to get the accreditation card.

The cards will be handed out on arrival at the Information Center. Lost accreditation card must be reported to the Information Center immediately.

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation has been reserved as follows

- The accommodation has shared shower and toilet facilities
- Women have their own shared shower and toilet facilities

When leaving the competition, used bed linens should be placed in laundry bags positioned in the container outside the barrack.

Clean your accommodation roughly before you leave.

Alcohol within the Garrison is not allowed.

WIFI ACCESS

WATER

All tap water is of good drinking quality.



REGULATIONS FOR USING THE BARRACKS

At ADR barracks or Cadet village

- Make sure you know where the nearest emergency exit is.
- Make sure you know where the gathering point is, look at the plan for emergency on the wall.
- Keep the emergency exits clear.
- Make sure that the fireproof doors are closed.
- Smoking is only allowed outdoors.
- Lighting of candles are strictly prohibited.
- Never leave inflammable material (wood and paper) for example at the entrances.

In case of fire

1. Locate the fire.
2. Rescue people in danger.
3. Close the doors and the windows to prevent smoke and fire to spread.
4. Call 112 for SOS-alarm.
5. Evacuate the building.
6. Make sure that all people have evacuated the building. Count everybody at the evacuation gathering point.
7. Contact the guard: +46 352663927.

SECURITY REGULATIONS

- The Swedish Air Defence Regiment is a military restricted area.
- Unauthorized personnel has no admittance to the Regimental areas.
- All visitors/guests must wear their accreditation card at all times when visiting the Regiment.
- Visitors/guests are only allowed to enter buildings or areas marked with a number in the team manual map. All other areas and buildings are NO GO areas.
- Photographing or filming at the regiment is prohibited.
- Filming and photographing is allowed at the obstacle run, throwing area, shooting range, cross country area and Brottet Swim Arena.
- Weapons and ammunition must be stored in armory when not supervised.
- It is not allowed to bring your own alcohol inside the Regimental area.
- Lost accreditation card must be reported to the Information Center immediately.




MAP OF THE AIR DEFENCE REGIMENT AREA






