1. Course purpose

Focusing on a migration and rescue at sea and in a land context. The CMR course will deepen the participant's knowledge and understanding of the mandates and modus operandi of parties involved in this kind of operation.

The Course is focusing on the opportunities and sensitivities that are inherently related to interaction and information sharing in this operational context, which requires interaction between civil-military-police/border control organisations.

The participant's will gain knowledge of the tools available in order to improve situational awareness, to facilitate information sharing and to effectively coordinate more effectively with external actors, as appropriate.

As the course progresses, participants will in a simulation exercise be exposed to the practical challenges on how to enable information exchange, establish and maintain a meaningful coordination relation, ranging from co-existence to cooperation, with NATO, United Nations, European Union and NGOs.

Previous SWEDINT CMR courses were UN orientated; CMR 1 (2019) is a pilot course, and a new course in its own right, which for the first time is focused on the NATO philosophy, doctrine and unity of effort.

3. Target Audience

The course is for relevant and identified civil, military and police personnel that are planning for, or who are already in ongoing positions in international operations related to migration in a sea or land context.

Application are welcome from: Military Staff Officers (OF 2-5), Warrant Officers, and equivalent civilian and police personnel, including staff members from International Organisations (IOs) and Non-Government Organisations (NGOs). Mission experience is not an application requirement.

All course work, documents, presentations and discussions will be in English; translators and translations of course materials are not provided. In accordance with NATO STANAG 6001 (2014), the English language proficiency levels and requirements of the CMR participant are:

- **Listening:** 3 - Professional
- **Speaking:** 2 - Functional
- **Reading:** 3 - Professional
- **Writing:** 3 - Professional

4. Performance Objectives (PO's)

Each PO is supported by Enabling Learning Objectives (ELO's); on completion of the course, participants will be able to:

- **Interpret** NATO and other mandates, directives and doctrine.
- **Develop** Civil-Military Interaction (CMI).
- **Implement** intelligence and information activities that support CMI.

Depth of Knowledge 300: Advanced Level (Apply).

6. Additional details

a) Course fee

The course fee is 6.000 SEK per participant. This includes board and lodging, and transfer from and to Stockholm Arlanda Airport (ARN) and Bromma Airport (BMA) in Stockholm/Sweden.

Salary, allowances and travel costs will be paid by the sending Nation or Organisation.

b) Subsidies

A subsidy is available on request by the nominating nation. Access to a participant subsidy is very limited.



Subsidies are decided on a case-by-case basis by the Swedish Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA). The relevant participant will indicate on the application form if he/she is applying for a subsidised course place.

If the subsidy box is not checked in the application form, SWEDINT will assume that no subsidies are being requested.

c) Visa requirements

If required, it is the responsibility of the participant to obtain their own visa; therefore, it is vital the CMR invitation reach the participant as early as possible.
