1975	Independence for Swarlana
1979	Military coup bringing General Dictato to power Falin group starts to dominate the Forces for the Defense of Swarlana (FDS)
1988	General Dictato's Death Elections held; President Ogavo wins Regime starts to fall; West intervenes with force
2002	Atsi-led opposition forms the Angels for a Democratic Swarlana (ADS)
2003	Elections held and President Ogavo wins for a fourth time Brotherhood for a free Swarlana (BFS) forms Comboo Defense Unit (CDU)
20 Dec of last year	Swarlana Ceasefire
28 Jan of this year	Kalari Comprehensive Peace Agreement (CPA)
04 Feb of this year	UN SCR 1543 (observe and monitoring mission only, Interim Multinational Force (IMF) for 3 months – March 01 to 01 June of this year) (document not included)
16 Feb of this year	Strength of all Armed Forces and groups to be declared
13-27 Feb of this year	Integrated Assessment Mission
