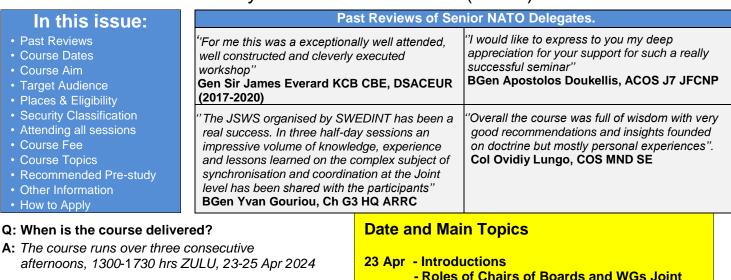
# Swedish Armed Forces International Centre (SWEDINT) BLUF

Supporting the SWEDINT Invitation for the online Senior Joint Synchronisation Course (SJSC) 2024.



#### Q: What is the aim of the course?

A: The aim of the course is to enhance the capacity of the Chair of Boards and Working Groups to undertake their roles and responsibilities for joint synchronisation more effectively.

### **Q: What is the Target Audience?**

A: OF5 – OF7 who are Chairs of Boards and Working Groups in Operational level HQs or TCC and their Board/WG Secretaries. GRF(L) HQs preparing as JFTs are also welcome.

#### Q: Who is eligible to attend?

A: 16 places are available on this course for delegates representing NCA and NFS HQs, JWC, JFTC, and those HQs preparing for LTRP, and selected Partner Nations of Australia, New Zealand and Sweden.

#### Q: What is the security classification?

A: The course is NATO UNCLASSIFIED

#### Q: Must I attend all three afternoon sessions?

**A:** To gain the full benefit, you should attend all 3 afternoon sessions.
