## Virtual Joint Synchronisation Workshop update

### Dates

The workshop will run on 3 consecutive afternoons from **1300-1730** hrs BRAVO time. These are **29 and 30 September, and 01 October 2020**. The dates have been selected to de-conflict with named NATO exercise planning events and before several of the HQs begin their Battle Staff Training events. The outline programme is below:

#### Q: What is the aim of the Workshop?

A: The aim of the workshop is to enhance the capacity of Chairs of Boards and Working Groups to undertake their roles and responsibilities for joint synchronisation more effectively.

#### Q: What is the Target Audience?

A: OF5 and OF6 who are Chairs of Boards and Working Groups in Operational level HQs or SSC and their Board/WG Secretaries. GRF(L) HQs preparing as JTFs are also welcome.

#### Q: Who is eligible to attend?

A: NCS and NFS HQs, JWC, JFTC, and those HQs preparing for LTRP. Selected Partner Nations, including Sweden, Finland, Australia and New Zealand.

#### Q: What is the security classification?

A: The workshop is NATO UNCLASSIFIED and likely to be conducted on NU Polycom Real Presence.

#### Q: Do I need to attend all three sessions?

A: To gain the full benefit, you should attend all 3 sessions.
